



NO DOUBT ANNOUNCED FOR FIRST EDITION OF ROCK IN RIO USA

Band will debut at Rock in Rio at its 30th anniversary edition in Las Vegas

NEW YORK, NY (September 26, 2014) – Rock in Rio USA has announced No Doubt for the first-ever U.S. edition of the festival taking place in Las Vegas on May 8-9 and May 15-16, 2015. This will be the band's first performance at the festival's Main Stage.

No Doubt made an appearance at the Times Square press conference where the organizers of the festival announced the first confirmed artists and pre-sale information. The band stated, "we are extremely happy to be taking the stage at Rock in Rio's first US festival and to be part of such an amazing festival celebrating its 30th anniversary".

No Doubt has achieved a lot as a band, releasing six albums and a string of chart-topping hits ("Just A Girl," "Don't Speak," "Hey Baby," "Hella Good," "Underneath It All," and "It's My Life") with over 33 million albums sold worldwide. They've launched international sold-out tours, won two Grammy Awards and five MTV Video Music Awards, performed at a Superbowl Halftime show, and were invited to perform a tribute to Paul McCartney for the President at the annual Kennedy Center Honors in 2010.

Through all the success, the band members have remained grounded by a long-standing friendship that began when vocalist Gwen Stefani, guitarist Tom Dumont, bassist Tony Kanal, and drummer Adrian Young — bonded by a shared love of '80s British New Wave and ska bands — began performing together in their hometown of Anaheim, CA.

Rock in Rio USA will take over the Las Vegas Strip for the first time on May 8-9 and May 15-16, 2015. The pre-sale for the festival begins today with tickets available at www.rockinrio.com/tickets.
